**First Look (Preschool and Kindergarten)** – The monthly theme for May is "I can help others." and the memory verse is: "Be kind and loving to each other." Ephesians 4:32, NCV. The Bible story this week is from Exodus 17:8-13, the story of Aaron helping Moses by holding his arms up when they get tired.



**252Basics (Grades 1 to 5)** – The monthly theme is "Honesty -2 Choosing to be truthful in whatever you say and do". The memory verse is, "Keep me from cheating and telling lies.
